

PROJECT #1

Basic Education Program for Primary School Students

1. General objective:

Improve access, quality and retention in primary education to ensure every child has a solid, inclusive and equitable educational foundation.

2. Background and justification:

In many regions, basic education remains marked by:

- And **limited access** at school for disadvantaged children;
- Of the **overcrowded classes**, little educational material;
- And **high dropout rate**, especially among girls;
- And **lack of continuing education** for teachers.

This project aims to strengthen basic education as the foundation of human and social development.

3. Specific objectives:

- Increase the enrollment rate of children aged 6 to 12.
- Improving the quality of teaching in primary schools.
- Reduce disparities linked to gender, disability or rurality.
- Strengthening the capacities of teachers and school committees.

4. Main activities:

A. Access and Equity:

- Raising awareness among communities about the education of children (especially girls).
- Distribution of free school kits (uniforms, bags, supplies).
- Establishment of school canteens to encourage attendance.

B. Educational quality:

- Continuing training of teachers in active pedagogy.
- Introduction of manuals and materials adapted to the level of the students.
- Implementation of differentiated teaching for children with difficulties.

C. Monitoring and support:

- Quarterly assessments of student achievement.
- Strengthening parent-teacher associations.
- Creation of school clubs (reading, environment, culture).

5. Zone d'intervention :

The project targets rural and urban primary schools in underserved regions (North - Center - Artibonite).

6. Target audience:

- Children aged 6 to 12
- Primary school teachers
- Parents and local communities
- School inspectors and principals

7. Duration of the project: 3 years, with phases:

- **Year 1:** Diagnosis, launch, first training sessions
- **Year 2:** Implementation of large-scale actions
- **Year 3:** Consolidation and evaluation

8. Forecast budget:

9. Expected results:

- 5,000 children registered and regularly enrolled in school
- 20% improvement in school assessment results
- 30% reduction in school dropout rate
- Teachers better equipped to meet students' needs

- Indicators: attendance rate, academic results, teacher progress.
- Biannual impact reports.
- Community participatory monitoring workshops.
